Exclusive Coach Interviews

The official start of the Super Bowl will be on Wednesday, December 25 at 12:00PM CST and during media day we were able to catch up with both coaches, Kyle Lindgren and Craig Lindgren Jr. Check out the unedited versions of their interviews below:

Interview with Sportsfreak coach Craig Lindgren Jr



Reporter: I would like to welcome to the interview room Craig Lindgren Jr the coach of Sportsfreak. Welcome and Congratulations Craig on a great season! It's been a while! In fact, six seasons since your last post season and last Super Bowl appearance. How does it feel to be back in the Super Bowl?

Craig: It feels pretty incredible. Had a few bad breaks over the years, but I never questioned my coaching and knew eventually, I would make it back to this spot.

Reporter: Before we dive into some Super Bowl questions let's talk briefly about this season and your playoff run to get here. You have been on a tear as of late, finishing out the regular season winning 5 of your last 6 games and now dominating here in the playoffs. Prior to that you were 4-4 and seemingly trying to figure things out. What changed midway through the season or how have you been able to have this success as of late?

Craig: This league is no joke. You play a lot of tough teams. You try to find your strategies as you go. so many of these games come down to coaching decisions so once I seen the potential in my team, we buckled down and started playing ball and you could really see how that played out at the end of the season going 5-1.

Reporter: I mentioned it has been 6 seasons since your last post season berth which was the longest of your career. Did you do something different this season that helped you break out of that slump?

Craig: One thing that made a big difference was I took off the weekend and focused on how to get the most success from my team and making sure I'm bring in the right people for my bench for injuries and bye weeks. Asked my assistant coaches Jude, Titus and Ari there thoughts or what I might be overlooking and then we executed. And as you can see it worked to perfection.

Reporter: The last time you were in the playoffs you made it all the way to the Super Bowl only to lose to BIGBOY! Now you have a chance at revenge. Have you thought about that or is it one of those scenarios where win or lose at least a Lindgren is winning the championship this year?

Craig: Well the last time we were here he would get really emotional when he would lose. So for a small chunk of money from his mother and some sympathy from myself being the older brother and wanting to see my little bro get some recognition and a moment to shine I don't think I gave it my all the first time around. Now that we are both older and he has had a decent career I won't make those same mistakes again.

Reporter: You have been a part of this league from the very beginning, and you know that winning championships is a big deal. You have yet to get your name on that trophy while both your brother and Father have. How important is it for you to get this first championship and get your name on that trophy?

Craig: This has been one of my top focus this year. I have had a lot of good seasons, but this year just feels different. My team is stacked and we are focused and ready to bring home the trophy.

Reporter: Let's dive into a few in season things and one of the things that stood out to me is that you had a relatively low amount of "moves" you made throughout the season. Of your 18 moves, only 6 of those were to add offensive players. This tells me that the bulk of your team is guys you drafted. Did the draft work out the way you wanted it and were you happy with your team after the draft?

Craig: I will say initially, the draft was not a 100% success I felt. But just like every good coach you build a team with what you have and looking back now I want to trade this team for the world they have played through many hard games came up big when I needed them too And as the season went, we grew closer and closer together. I felt like in the draft my wr were going to be the strength of my team. But my RB's have been the backbone the team. This group of guys have played hard and thats why I know we will win. Can't wait to hold that trophy up high for them.

Reporter: The one thing that stands out to me when looking at your draft is your two rookies. Brian Thomas Jr (6th round) and Bucky Irving (11th round). These two players have been a big reason why you have had the success you have the last few weeks. Were these two rookies you had targeted going into the draft?

Craig: Thomas I was pretty excited about and he has proven to be a home run in the draft. Irving I knew he had potential and talent but wasn't sure how much of a chance he would get this year. But talk about the type of guy you want going into the playoffs. He has been a stud at the end of the year and plan on one more game of him being a workhorse.

Reporter: Another one of your better picks was getting A. Kamara in the 4th round. He finished the season as RB6. You have had Kamara on your team frequently over the years. Is he someone you are always targeting on draft day?

Craig: He is a player I really do like. If I am honest he has let me down before but I always like his catching ability. This year I was pretty high on him going into the draft and this time he didn't let me down. I know we are both hoping he can play this week for this big championship game his veteran leadership is needed.

Reporter: Last thing related to draft day is that you have a really well-rounded roster where if one guy is out or bye weeks hit others could step in and fill that void. Did you take that into consideration when drafting or was it more of a pick the best player available approach?

Craig: I didn't look at the byes to much I just took the guys on the board that I felt were the best at that time. Reporter: Was there any extra feelings of satisfaction given that you were in this same position last season and Bossman knocked you out of the playoffs?


Kyle: That said, it feels great to top Bossman. Every time we're on the field together, we challenge each other

Kyle: James Conner was a must-have for me this season. Ladd, though, was one of the most frustrating picks I've made—I was running out of time and couldn't grab the player I truly wanted at that spot. They say the best player is an available player, and that's true. I've learned lessons like everyone else—look at McCaffrey.
